Eastmont Middle School Land Trust Summary for 2019-20

**Results must be interpreted with caution, as the final Inventories were not given due to the COVID-19 related school closure in March.

Goal #1: Reading

Eastmont Middle School will increase the percentage of students proficient on the Reading Inventory (RI) by at least 15% from fall to spring during the 2019-2020 school year, using data from grade level cohorts as measurement.

Expenditures:

- We hired a full-time reading teacher (.25 FTE paid for with Land Trust), and funded 1-24 hour/week reading para-educator to help with learning tasks and track progress in small groups and individually, and to aid students in the classroom setting.
- We provided supplies to those students as needed, including technology, to eliminate barriers to learning.
- We provided substitutes for teacher teams to plan assessments and interventions.

Results:

Fall to WINTER: 6th grade increased proficiency levels by 9%, 7th grade increased proficiency levels by 2% and 8th grade increased proficiency levels by 8%

Goal #2: Early Warning System

In the 2019-20 school year, 80% of Eastmont Middle School students will be on track for Ds & Fs by term 4 as measured by Canyons Early Warning System.

Expenditures:

- We hired one-24 hour para educator, to assist with identifying students at risk of failure, to help with learning tasks and track progress in small groups and individually, and to aid students in the classroom setting.
- We extended 7 additional hours to our special education para educator's contract to assist with identifying students at risk of failure, to help with learning tasks and track progress in small groups and individually, and to aid students in the classroom setting.
- We hired 2-10 hour para educators to assist with identifying students at risk of failure, to help with learning tasks and track progress in small groups and individually, and to aid students in the classroom setting.

Results:

Terms 1 to 3 data from the early warning systems are as follows:

- 6th grade
 - Term 1 91% of students were on track
 - Term 2 85% of students were on track
 - Term 3 81% of students were on track
- 7th grade
 - Term 1 74% of students were on track
 - Term 2 59% of students were on track
 - Term 3 58% of students were on track
- 8th grade
 - \circ ~ Term 1 72% of students were on track
 - \circ ~ Term 2 58% of students were on track
 - Term 3 65% of students were on track
