- We didn't attend the AVID conference this year online because the experience is a big part of the conference and the fact that we can meet together during the conference to make a plan.

Continued Learning Friday

- 1. high level overview-
 - We have had one teacher work day and it boosted morale with the teachers, they aren't feeling so overloaded, and they feel they aren't as worn down from all the time spent at home working.
 - One teacher reported he finally felt that he had the time to create lesson plans that accommodate all learners.
 - We did not have much parent contact during their office hours so some teachers are making outreach phone calls.
 - Tomorrow we are having an orientation for students who are leaving for online instruction and this Friday we are holding an orientation for students who are returning to in-person learning.

Online students/In person learning-

Format survey - how many kids are switching?

• 45 students are coming back to in-person learning and 17 students are going to online instruction. We have 160 students online and 500 students who are receiving in-person instruction.

School Safety Plan (this is usually on the agenda for the fall, but if we don't have anything, feel free to strike it)

- We will always support a walking path for students that is well lit.
- Dark sky friendly
- There is a pathway from Sego Lily to Countrywood
- We do have new walking routes and Taylor Hanson is working on updating our current Safe Walking Route Plan.
- We would want sidewalks and could partner with Edgemont
- We would support asking for the path with Bear Park and we need to complete the SCC Safety Report

Our safety concerns are:

- 1. Backpacks in the school/no locker use
- 2. Students are with their own cohort during a fire drill and each class is lined up in a marked parking stall.
- 3. Get 2nd Steps conversation starters out to parents.
- 4. We would request getting cameras in our stairwells.
- 5. We would also request that there is a camera installed out by the walking bridge.

Digital Citizenship:

- 1. The district has a program called Content Keeper, all of the student's computers have specific filters that are flagged when students are looking up inappropriate topics. Admin immediately calls parents once the email is sent to us by the district.
- 2. Should we be educating parents about how to use appropriate filters in order to avoid inappropriate information while they are at home.
- 3. We should educate parents on what appropriate screen time involves. We could get talking points for parents.
- 4. Educate parents on Common Sense media.
- 5. Link Video from our POM speaker and send home talking points to parents.

Counseling update:

- 1. We are not holding Reality Town this year. 8th graders will be able to choose which career they are interested in and watch a presentation through Google Meets and then students can ask questions for 5 minutes. All presentations will be recorded so that AVID teachers and CCA can use them as well.
- 2. We are currently analyzing reading data using set criteria to either move students in or out of reading.
- 3. Online talking circles are occurring on Fridays with online learners to support them with socialization. We could also do a live lesson with 2nd Steps on Fridays to support their social and emotional health. Paras, counselors, the school psychologist and our social worker could teach the 2nd Steps lessons.
- 4. There could be a drawing on Fridays and a prize will be dropped off at the winner's home.
- 5. Possibly have staff connect with our online learners on Fridays so they have a point person of contact. Case management
